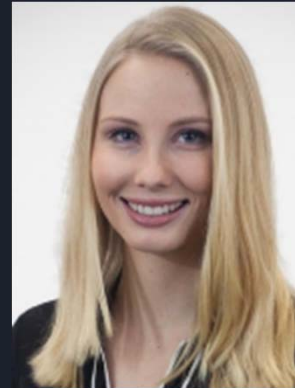

To learn about the different company cultures and to build relationships outside of Bermuda.

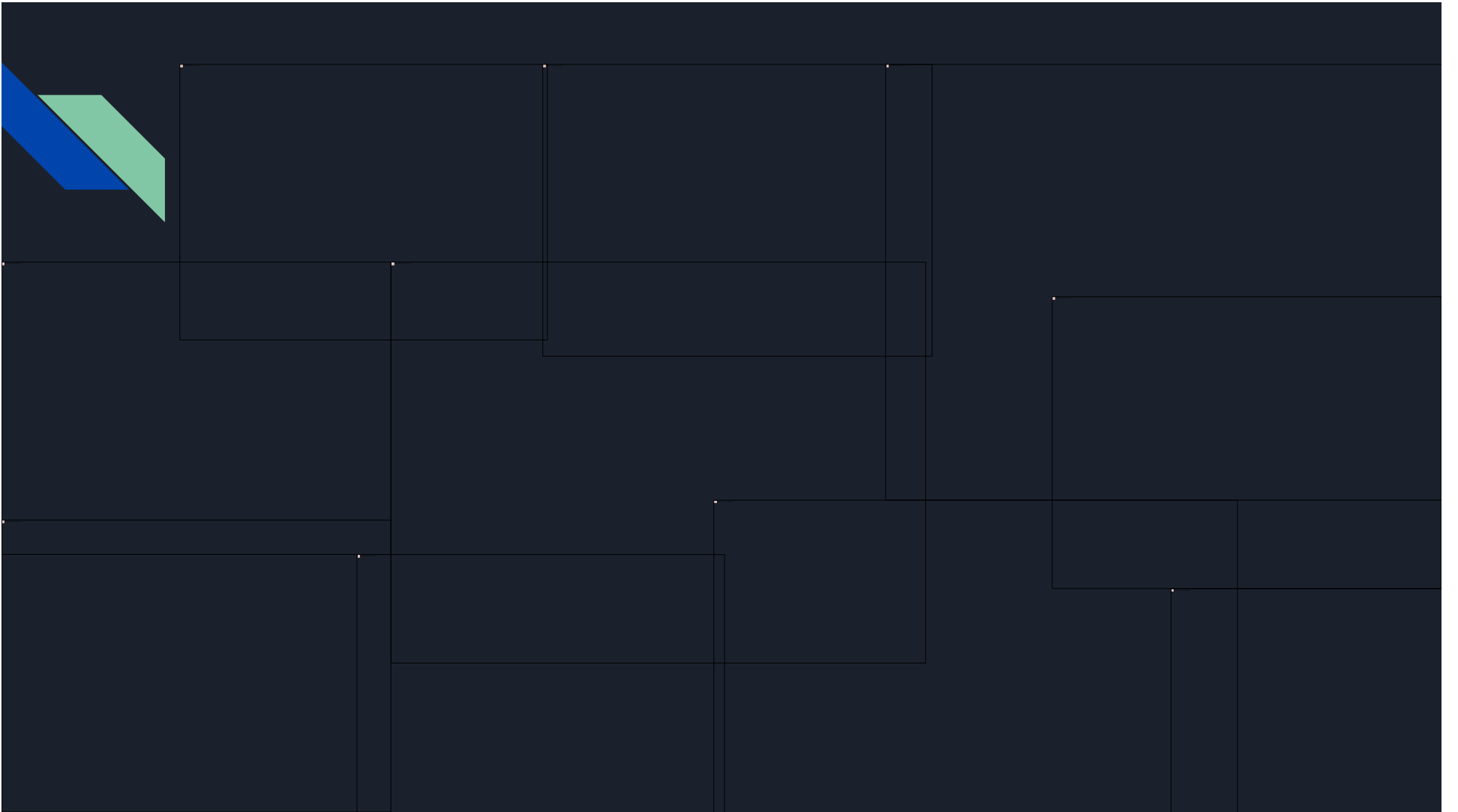


Expand my network outside of Bermuda and to learn more about various careers paths in the Insurance industry.

 - Learning the difference between retail/wholesale brokers, managing general agent



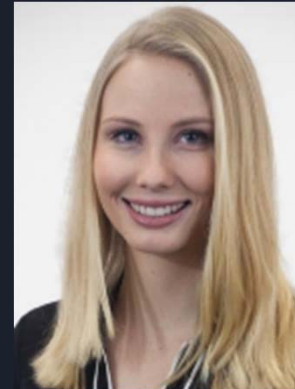



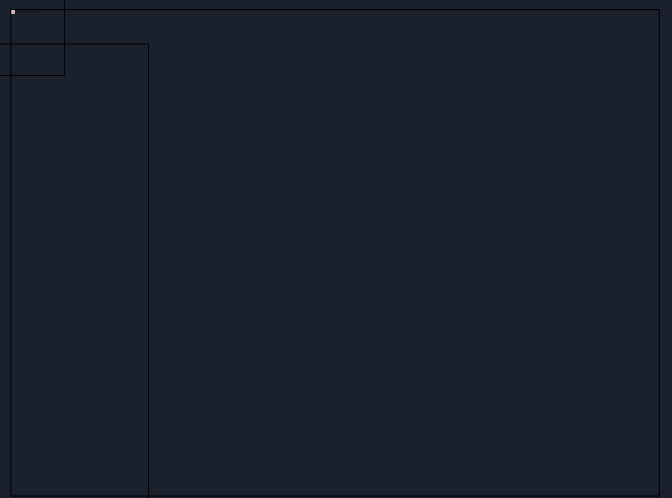
